

Budgens Stores Ltd

The first Budgens store was founded in 1872, by John Budgen. The first stores were small local grocers, which expanded across the South of England.

In October 1997, Budgens acquired the 55 store UK network of 7-11 stores, re-branding them with the concept name 'B2'. Soon afterwards it was clear that the name wasn't popular with customers and the 30 stores that were outside London began trading under 'Budgens' fascia. The 'B2' branded stores in London were then changed to 'Budgens Express' before finally reverting to the 'Budgens' brand.

Budgens and Heat & Screed Ltd

Heat & Screed Ltd were asked to install a floor screed by a returning client at a Budgens Store in Somerset. The previous screed which had been installed by others had failed, and was unsuitable for the installation of the Resin Floor finish.

The failed screed was removed by the main contractor. Heat & Screed Ltd then installed a high density EPS150 Insulation, Polythene and 75mm Flexidry FO screed mixed at 1:3. This provided a high strength (minimum 30N/mm² after 28 days) floor screed for commercial use, and was sufficiently dry in time for the Resin Floor Finish to be installed.

The screed was pumped into the building. The project which was 265m² in total was completed in 3 days. The screed installed by Heat & Screed Ltd passed the compressive strength test and the resin was installed by our customer.
