A British pub chain headquartered in Watford, Hertfordshire; was founded in 1979 by Tim Martin, the company owns 860 outlets. The company also operates the Lloyds No. 1 nightclub chain and a modest number of Wetherspoon Hotels.

The chain champions: Cask Ale, Low Prices, Long Opening Hours, and No Music.

The chain has become known for converting large, unconventional premises into pubs, including cinemas, post offices, and banks, such as The Standing Order in Derby and Becketts Bank in Leeds. Premises tend to be large by British pub standards, and utilise an open plan layout.

JD Wetherspoon and Heat & Screed Ltd

Throughout 2012 Heat & Screed Ltd completed various JD Wetherspoon Pubs, Nationwide; including installations in County Durham, Whitby in North Yorkshire & Fakenham in Norfolk.

Our client: required a fast drying screed that had to be compatible with the resin flooring that was next to be installed. Heat & Screed recommended the use of Flexidry FO with a 1:3 mix to give superior strength and a three day drying time. As most JD Wetherspoon Pubs are in town centre locations, access is quite restricted, Heat & Screed Ltd pumped the screed into the working areas and had all materials delivered in Bulk Bags. The Floor Screed was installed to falls.
